BOOMERANG: A Career Development Program

Innovation Tri-Valley Leadership Group (ITV) is led by the region's business leaders and influencers committed to connecting the businesses, research labs, educational institutions, and civic leaders. This collaborative force is focused on generating job growth and economic vitality for the Tri-Valley.

ITV recognizes that to achieve its goals, there exists a critical need to better connect students **from the Tri-Valley** with local industry partners to meet our present and future workforce needs. This realization led to the creation of the **Boomerang Project, a career development summer program focused on graduating high school seniors and college freshmen and sophomores**. Regardless of where our local students go off to college, we want them to return (i.e. "boomerang") home to grow their careers right here in the Tri-Valley.

ITV believes our students benefit from local work-based learning opportunities as it enhances their skills and creates greater connections with Tri-Valley employers. Our local industry partners benefit from the production of these talented students while training those who will be driving our region's economic future. By connecting our emerging young professionals with local industry leaders and each other now, we can help fuel our region's growth and vitality for years to come.

Boomerang is an **8-week paid internship program from June 17-August 9 where students work approximately 15-20 hours per week**. Interns will be placed through mutual agreement of the employer and student at one of our industry partners in a field related to their career goals. Placements will be based upon both the employer's needs and the qualifications of the applicant.

In addition to the internship, there will also be **workshops (usually Thursday evenings from 6:30-8:00) at The Switch**, which is a co-working space in Downtown Livermore serving startups and entrepreneurs in the Tri-Valley. There will also be **site visits to Tri-Valley employers, mentorship meetings with industry leaders, and networking events**. Boomerang is done in **partnership** with the **Pedrozzi Foundation, our region's school districts, and Las Positas College** where the opportunity to earn college credit is available.

Interested students need to submit a **cover letter** expressing why they wish to apply, along with a **resume** and completed **application** to Tim Sbranti at tsbranti@innovationtrivalley.org.
